Hello Fifth Grade Families,

We are very excited for the 2018–2019 school year. Your child's teacher may have mentioned our plan for 5<sup>th</sup> grade activities this year during Kickoff Orientation. Students are invited to participate in 8 field trips throughout the year. All of the trips are correlated to our IB units of inquiry or serve as team building activities that are intended to strength our 5<sup>th</sup> grade learning community. Below is the proposed plan with tentative dates:

Please note that other than Space Camp, trips with two dates listed indicate that half of the class will attend one date, and the remaining students will attend the second date. Your child's teacher will communicate which date your child will attend.

The approximate total cost for these experiences is \$400 per student. This total takes into account our anticipated fundraising and parent support through the grade level grant from PTA/PAWS. Through these initiatives, we anticipate that we can offset the cost \$100 from the actual cost of \$500 per student. In order to fund our experiences, we have developed some payment plan options for covering the costs of the activities:

- O OPTION A: Pay the full total of \$400 by August 30th
- O OPTION B: Pay \$50 by August 30th, pay \$150 by October 30th, pay \$200 by February 28th for a total of \$400
- O OPTION C: Pay \$50 by the 30<sup>th</sup> of each month August March (February is due the 28<sup>th</sup>) for a total of \$400

Attached is you will find permission slips for the first two field trips, a payment plan selection form with payment envelope attached, and a scholarship form for this year's class activities. Permission slips for subsequent field trips, as well as packing lists and arrival/departure logistics for extended day and overnight trips, will be sent home closer to the trip dates. The payment plan selection form and first cash payment should be submitted **no later than AUGUST** 30th. In the event that your family needs assistance covering all or some of the costs of the activities, please complete the attached scholarship form and submit it to your child's teacher. Additionally, if you are interested in sponsoring a student by providing a full or partial scholarship, please complete the attached form and submit it to your child's teacher. No donation is too small! As a Teasley community, our goal is to support the 5th grade class so that we can have 100% student participation. Financial restraints should not be a factor in keeping any student from participating.

As previously mentioned, the 5<sup>th</sup> grade class will be organizing several fundraisers throughout the school year to offset the costs of the class activities. It will be imperative to have parent volunteers to support those fundraising initiatives. We will provide details for those fundraisers in the coming weeks. Please be on the lookout for that information. We also plan to host an information session for all 5<sup>th</sup> grade parents where we will provide additional details for those interested in attending the overnight field trip as a chaperone. We will provide plenty of notice prior to the meeting.
